We have several **action items** that the Leadership Board, several Task Force groups, and staff will be working on in the coming weeks.

- 1. Continue to review and audit our ministries and clergy and staff job descriptions to come in alignment with our mission and vision (NLI Goal 1).
- 2. Develop a 3-5 year sustainability plan for Indian Church RVA (NLI Goal 1).
- 3. Bring the budget process in alignment with the vision and ministry goals (NLI Goal 1).

- 1. The renovation of restrooms in the Education Hallway and painting of the entry wall in Wistar Hall. Thank you to the leadership of Jim Mallon and the work of a dedicated team this summer! (NLI Goal 4 God's Space).
- 2. The completion of the first review and audit of our current outreach and mission ministries by the Next Level Missions Task Force (NLI Goal 2).
