	lead my family in devotions or prayers	
	begin to make meaning of Bible stories (how do they affect your daily life)	
	talk about God - where you see and experience God in everyday life	
	know what your special gifts are and give using your gifts (music, art,	
	helping younger kids, donate money, reading, writing, etc.)	
	participate in a short term family mission experience

	intentionally think about how Bible stories relate to your daily life

	do things for others because you know it's the right thing to do make intentional decisions to befriend others
